INTRODUCTION/AIMS

HAIR AND JEWELLERY

Similarly, for health and safety reasons, children should not wear jewellery or watches during P.E. lessons. If your child has pierced ears, please ensure that they wear studs.

If your child needs to wear any form of jewellery for religious purposes, we ask that you kindly inform the Headteacher.
