Parking

There are parking restrictions in the streets around the school with parking bays and pay and display machines in operation. However, there are double yellow lines along School Road and it is both illegal and extremely dangerous to leave a parked car on the yellow lines.

People with young children walking to school are easily obscured by parked vehicles and could be knocked down. Please take the trouble to park in the other streets near the school and help ensure that the area around the school entrance is as safe as we can possibly make it.

Dogs

Please can we politely request that you do not tie your dogs(s) to the barriers outside the school gates. Some children are frightened of dogs or may be allergic to them. The entrance gate can be very busy and children may struggle to avoid them if they are tied too close to the school gates.
