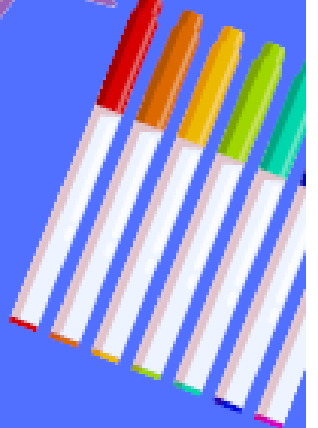
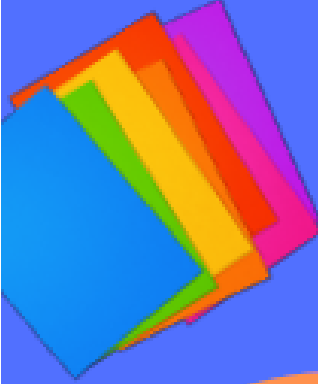


Hove Learning Federation is a Nut Free and Sesame Seed Free School
